

PACIFIC COAST FOAM PROVIDES ARCHITECTURAL FOAM DETAILS FOR NEW CAMDEN TUSCANY IN SAN DIEGO'S LITTLE ITALY

SAN DIEGO - December 18, 2002 - Pacific Coast Foam (PCF) is providing the custom exterior architectural shapes and accents for the new Camden Tuscany (see attached photo), a mixed-use residential project located in San Diego's Little Italy, along the west side of Kettner Boulevard, between Cedar and Date streets, according to Scott J. Buckley, vice president of sales and marketing for PCF, San Diego's largest supplier and installer of expanded polystyrene (EPS) foam architectural shapes and accents.

PCF's innovative work includes the fabrication of a custom pre-coated decorative details such as crown molding, window trim, column capitals and balcony accents. When completed in December, Camden Tuscany will be comprised of 163 apartment units with 8,000 square feet of retail space and parking. The owner/builder of Camden Tuscany is Camden Development; the architect is ARK Architects; and the construction manager is Nielsen Dillingham. PCF was retained by Ghianni-LaRussa Group, the plastering contractor.
