

## PACIFIC COAST FOAM PROVIDES LYKESTONE ARCHITECTURAL SHAPES AND ACCENTS FOR NEW CHAMPIONS CENTER

SAN DIEGO - October 22, 2001 - Architectural shapes and accents made from Pacific Coast Foam's exclusive LykeStone finish now adorn the new five-story, 87,000-square-foot Champions Center at 12264 El Camino Real in the San Diego Corporate Center, according to Scott J. Buckley, vice president of sales and marketing for Pacific Coast Foam (PCF), San Diego's largest supplier and installer of expanded polystyrene (EPS) foam architectural shapes and accents.

The new office building, valued at \$19 million, features architectural shapes and accents made from PCF's LykeStone smooth concrete finish, including parapet trim pieces, crown molding, belly band molding, top and bottom window pediments and various trim accents. "The shapes and accents are both lightweight and provide 'zero' intrusion into the building's exterior versus the typical straps and bolts needed to mount heavy precast concrete accents to the building's exterior," Buckley said.

Pacific Coast Foam was retained by Mirstone Plastering of Chula Vista, which handled the installation of the foam materials. Owned by All Star Equities LLC, the Champions Center is located adjacent to the Champions of the West Plaza. Both buildings were designed by architect Dale Naegle. The project architect is Hanna Gabriel Wells and the general contractor is Sundt Construction Co.
