

THE PCF GROUP PROVIDES CUSTOM LYKEWOOD ARCHITECTURAL ACCENTS FOR THE EASTLAKE COMPANY'S CLUBHOUSE AT THE WOODS

SAN DIEGO — November 21, 2003 — The PCF Group (PCF) has provided the interior architectural details for The Eastlake Company's new Clubhouse at the Woods in Chula Vista, according to Scott J. Buckley, vice president of marketing for PCF, San Diego's largest supplier and installer of expanded polystyrene (EPS) foam architectural shapes and accents.

PCF custom manufactured and installed the custom faux timber wood grain texture and custom color for the Clubhouse beams made from its popular LykeWood series. PCF worked closely with Design Line Interiors, the interior designer, and The Eastlake Company, the general contractor, on the project. Design Line Interiors and Architect R. Douglas Mansfield of Laguna Beach emulated a Floridian Resort Style of architecture for the Clubhouse that was advanced by legendary architect Addison Mizner in the 1920s. In addition, Conover of San Diego was the color and materials consultant for the Clubhouse. A private resident club, it includes swimming pools, spa, a fitness room, demonstration kitchen, and formal and informal gathering areas all within a uniquely designed two-story recreation complex.
