

## PCF TO PROVIDE EXTERIOR FOAM ARCHITECTURAL ACCENTS FOR UNIVERSITY OF SAN DIEGO'S NEW EAST CAMPUS STUDENT APARTMENTS

SAN DIEGO - June 24, 2002 - PCF will provide the custom exterior architectural accents for the new East Campus Student Apartments, which are currently under construction at the University of San Diego, according to Scott J. Buckley, vice president of sales and marketing for PCF, San Diego's largest supplier and installer of expanded polystyrene (EPS) foam architectural shapes and accents.

Decorative column panels, parapet and cornice moldings, banding trim and finials are among the decorative exterior accents manufactured from expanded polystyrene (EPS) foam by PCF and featured on the new USD student apartments. When completed in August, the USD East Campus Student Apartments will feature 224 1, 2 and 4 bedroom apartments and 132 shared bedroom apartments. The units will be fully furnished with full kitchens. The apartments, staffed and managed by USD, will have Ethernet connectivity and provide underground parking,
